Tapestry Public Charter School Policy Manual Policy on Use of Private Cars for Transporting Students

The Tapestry Public Charter School Board adopts the following policy, effective on the date of adoption by the Board.

In some occasions, it may be necessary for Tapestry to allow an employee to transport students for official school activities. Employees who transport students for school purposes <u>must have the permission of the school leader or the Board</u>. This policy statement applies to transportation of students for school purposes. When the school leader or Board determines it is appropriate for an employee to transport students, the following stipulations must be followed:

- 1. The driver must be 23 years of age and have a valid, unrestricted Georgia Driver's License.
- 2. A copy of the driver's license and a certificate of insurance for the vehicle being used must be provided. The policy must be current and must include the following minimum liability coverage: \$100,000 per person, \$300,000 per bodily injury occurrence, \$50,000 property damage.
- 3. The driver shall comply with all motor vehicle laws and regulations of the state in which the driver travels including laws and regulations covering car registration, driver's license, and state vehicle inspections.
- 4. There must be at least 2 adults in the vehicle.
- 5. The number of persons in the vehicle must not exceed the number of operable seat belts. The driver and passengers will use available passenger restraints at all times when the vehicle is in motion. No private vehicle with more than ten seats including the driver should be used; this includes vans. No one should ride in the bed of a pick-up truck.
- 6. Drivers who have been convicted of a misdemeanor or felony driving under the influence will not be authorized to drive students.
- 7. Drivers who have been charged with a misdemeanor or felony driving under the influence or a serious moving violation will not be authorized to drive students pending disposition of their case.
- 8. Drivers with more than one moving violation within the past two years will not be authorized to drive students.
- 9. Drivers must go directly from the point of departure to the point of destination.
- 10. Vehicles for transporting students must be in a safe and operable condition.
- 11. There must be a permission slip on file for each student traveling in a personally owned vehicle.
- 12. No mileage will be paid to drivers.
